

CONDUCT OF THE NEW ZEALAND LAW AND PRACTICE EXAMINATION REGULATIONS 1996

1. Name and Commencement

- (1) These regulations may be cited as the Conduct of the New Zealand Law and Practice Examination (Amendment) Regulations 2010, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Conduct of the New Zealand Law and Practice Examination Regulations 1996 (the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 2011.

2. New Zealand Law and Practice Examination Venue

- (1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting after paragraph (2) the following paragraph —
 - “(3) The Examination is to be held at each of the University law faculties in New Zealand. The Council may also allow the Examination to be sat at one overseas centre in London, the United Kingdom to be determined by the Council.”
- (2) Regulation 8(2) of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words “an overseas centre”, and substituting the words “the overseas venue.”

3. Concessions

Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the final sentence of paragraph (4), the sentence —

“Except in exceptional circumstances an application under this clause shall be made within one month of receipt of the candidate’s results.”

4. Recount of Marks

The principal regulations are amended by deleting regulation 12, and renumbering all following regulations accordingly.
